### ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

In the new challenging era, it seems to be necessary to **(re-)define** the goals and tasks of the **entire system of teacher education**. Without devaluing the high relevance of comprehensive initial teacher education it seems to be necessary to clarify which competencies and attitudes prospective teachers may be able to develop during initial teacher education.

NCTE also notified the same and made wide range reforms in Teacher Education & recognised for the first time three new programmes – 4-year B.A/B.Sc. B.Ed., 3-year B.Ed. (Part-time), and 3-year B.Ed.-M.Ed. programme. Each programme curriculum comprises three components – theory, practicum, internship in which ICT, Yoga Education, Gender and Disability/Inclusive Education are integral part of each programme curriculum.

By ensuring that only serious aspirants opt to be the part of teaching profession like in the case for engineering or medicine & to produce quality and competent teachers by achieving the planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system throughout the country, the ministry is now planning to revamp the two year B Ed course to a 4-year integrated teacher training programme. The Finance Minister, Hon'ble Sh. Arun Jaitley has also made announcement on the same during Budget Session 2018. NCTE sources endorsed that the revamped syllabus for the integrated BA-BEd and BSc-BEd will be broader, practical-oriented and will cover the whole gamut of teacher education programmes including research and training of persons for equipping them to teach at middle, secondary and senior secondary stages in schools. This four-year B.Ed. (Integrated) programme plays a major role in equipping the young aspirants planning to make a career as a teacher with comprehensive knowledge focused on best teaching practices and community-oriented approach to teaching.
