Guru Tegh Bahadur was the ninth [Sikh Guru](#) and second [Sikh](#) martyr, who sacrificed his life for religion and for the protection of the human rights. The martyrdom day of Guru Tegh Bahadur is celebrated every year on November 24.

Guru Tegh Bahadur's Martyrdom Day is also observed as [Shaheedi Diwas](#) and was celebrated at Guru Nanak College of Education on 29th November 2022 so as to pay honour and tribute to Guru Tegh Bahadur's sacrifice while guarding the religious sentiments of people.
