Delhi University's SGTB Khalsa College hosted the first-ever Sikh Congress in collaboration with Indian Council for Historical Research (ICHR) and Indira Gandhi National Centre for Arts(IGNCA) from 05.01.2023 to 07.01.2023, in which the students of GNCE were also in attendance. The three-day conference, which was organised under the patronage of Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee, was inaugurated on Thursday with Sikh historians from across the country participating in the event. They traced the evolution of Sikh history from the 15th century.

Uttarakhand governor Gurmit Singh was the chief guest who urged the audience to live their lives in accordance with the core teachings of Sikhism as it exists between the spectrum of divinity and valour. He also spoke of the need to rewrite the pages of history so that they can do justice to the strength and sacrifice of the Sikh community over the ages.

DU vice-chancellor Yogesh Singh also echoed similar sentiments in his address and said it was time to fill the gaps in Indian history by giving adequate representation to the contributions of Sikhs in nation-building.
