Since, comprehension is the ultimate goal of reading, the importance of vocabulary development cannot be overestimated. A robust vocabulary improves all areas of communication — listening, speaking, reading and writing.

Acknowledging the above-mentioned fact, GNCE understood it, as its prima facie task to organise an Enhancing Vocabulary Workshop for its students of Batch 2021-23, Semester-II on 08.07.2022 in co-operation with the respected Resource Person- Mr. Vimal Kumar.

Vocabulary is critical to an individual's success as vocabulary growth is directly related to achievement. A 2012 study by Meredith Rowe, an Associate Professor of Education in the Graduate School of Education at Harvard, discusses the ideas of quantity versus quality of speech used with individuals. At early ages (between 12 and 24 months), the amount of language used is important. Parents and other caregivers should speak to the child all the time and provide consistent word models. Children need to hear words modelled many times before they will begin to use the words, so the more frequently they are exposed to words, the better the likelihood that they will gain that word in their vocabulary.
